

Post Vaccination Admissions and Return to Facility Protocol- COVID-19 Marbridge Foundation

This protocol is implemented secondary to the local, state, and national emergency related to COVID-19. It remains a fluid policy based on variable factors, including but not limited to, continued recommendations from the local, state, and national health authorities.

If an outbreak occurs at a Marbridge community, the community's ability to admit or return residents is overseen by local and state health authorities.

RECOMMENDED ISOLATION AND QUARANTINE PERIODS:

Resident that tests positive for COVID-19:

- All residents, regardless of vaccination status:
 - Isolate in room for five (5) days.
 - If resident has no symptoms or symptoms are resolving (with no fever for 24 hours) after five (5) days, resident can exit isolation.
 - Resident should wear a mask around others and not attend any large indoor gatherings for five (5) additional days.

Resident with close exposure to COVID-10

Close exposure is defined as prolonged, unmasked, and indoor exposure to someone with COVID-19.

- If resident has been boosted, completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last six months, or completed the primary series of Johnson & Johnson withing the last two months:
 - \circ Wear a mask around others for ten (10) days.
 - \circ Receive a rapid antigen test on day five (5).
 - If resident develops symptoms at any time, they should isolate and receive a COVID-19 test as soon as possible.
- If resident completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over six months ago and are not boosted, completed the primary series of Johnson & Johnson over two months ago and are not boosted, or are unvaccinated:
 - Quarantine in room for five (5) days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for five (5) additional days.
 - Receive a rapid antigen test on day five (5).
 - If resident develops symptoms at any time, they should isolate and receive a COVID-19 test as soon as possible.

Vaccinated resident:

• Upon day of admission, new resident will participate in education on recognizing COVID-19 symptoms, use and compliance of face mask, hand hygiene, and respiratory hygiene. Documentation of education to be filed at community.

Family involvement:

- Families of residents who are admitting to the communities may assist the newly admitted resident with settling into their new environment if the following criteria is met.
 - Resident and family are asymptomatic for any infectious disease.
 - Family members are screened upon arrival per facility protocol.
 - Family members must remain socially distanced from other residents.

RESIDENTS RETURNING TO CAMPUS FROM HOME VISITS

Vaccinated or unvaccinated resident returning to campus:

• Resident will receive a rapid antigen test on day five (5) of return.

*Please note that all symptomatic residents are required to quarantine and test for COVID-19 as clinically indicated, regardless of vaccination status.
